AERONAUTICAL INFORMATION CIRCULAR

IMPLEMENTATION OF PERSONNEL LICENSING AND TRAINING
KNOWLEDGE REQUIREMENTS IN RELATION TO HUMAN FACTORS
FOR ALL LICENCES HOLDERS

Background

The knowledge requirements for Human Factors for all licence holders were introduced by ICAO in 2001 and subsequently in the Civil Aviation (Air Navigation) Regulations in 2004 and (2010).

Compliance Requirements

With effect from 01 February 2012, licence holders not complying with Human Factors requirements will not be meeting international standards and will have their licences endorsed as such. The endorsement, in terms of International law means they must not operate on international flights unless with specific consent of the concerned State.

Those who obtained Zimbabwean licence through conversion of foreign licences must show proof of passing the Human Factors examination to be considered for exemption. In the absence of evidence of compliance the holder will have to undertake the appropriate examination.
