Standardization of Flight Test

Students being tested by the Civil Aviation Authority's examiners are requested to come fully prepared.

Each student must be in possession of the appropriate plates, a completed flight log containing columns for ETA and ATA, sufficient space to obtain ATIS and write down clearances and a torch if the flight is likely to land after dark. A checklist must be used. A copy of the checklist should be submitted to the Authority for approval before the test. If an aircraft is equipped for flying in icing conditions, icing drills will be simulated during the test. Therefore students should familiarize themselves with the procedures. Prior to departure, students will be requested to give a Captain's brief, so that each party will precisely know what to do in the event of an accident.

The test does not end until the aircraft is parked on the apron and all aspects of the flight are being judged. Failure to comply with these prerequisites will automatically stop the test from happening and a fail will be entered on the student's file.
