## **AERONAUTICAL INFORMATION CIRCULAR**

### **PERSONNEL LICENSING AND TRAINING**

#### **TRAINING FOR THE ISSUE OF LICENCES OR RATINGS**

Statutory Instrument 140 of 2010 published by the Minister of Transport and Infrastructural Development contains regulations for Approved Training Organizations (ATO) under Part 3. Civil Aviation Authority of Zimbabwe (CAAZ) approves the training organizations in compliance with these regulations. It is a prerequisite that such organizations are approved by Ministry of Higher Education amongst other requirements.

The Authority will thus, with effect from 01 February 2014, extend implementation of these regulations to all training of aviation personnel leading to the issue of any civil aviation licenses or ratings. This is in order for the State of Zimbabwe to comply with prevailing international standards as published by ICAO in 2011 in Annex 1 Personnel Licensing and Training.

Consequently, this entails that all training that is required for the issue of licenses or ratings shall be conducted under an Approved Training Organization. The Authority will only issue ratings or licenses to applicants who would have successfully completed training at a CAAZ approved ATO.
